## International Scholar Statistics July 01, 2022 - June 30, 2023


## **Background Information**

These statistics represent international scholars who engaged in research and teaching at UNM on J-1 visas between July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023. There were an additional 44 J-1 medical residents on visa documents from the Educational Commission of Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) at the UNM Health Sciences Center. These J-1 residents are not represented in these statistics. Finally, UNM faculty and staff on other visa types are also not represented due to lack of accurate data on these individuals.

## **Observations**


- There was a 34.21% increase in the number of J-1 scholars over the last year (2022 2023)
- Scholars came to UNM from 40 countries.
- More than 65.69% of J-1 scholars came from Spain, India, China, Brazil and Mexico.
- The top 5 disciplines (more than 90%) for J-1 scholars are: Visual & Performing Arts, Life Sciences/Biological Sciences, Physical Sciences, Engineering, and Health Sciences.
- 44% of scholars are funded from US sources such as UNM, the US government and private US sponsors
  while 55% of scholars are funded by their home government, a private foreign sponsor, International
  Organization or personal and family funds.




