International Scholar Statistics July 01, 2021 - June 30, 2022

Background Information


These statistics represent international scholars who engaged in research and teaching at UNM on J-1 visas between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022. There were an additional 38 J-1 medical residents on visa documents from the Educational Commission of Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) at the UNM Health Sciences Center. These J-1 residents are not represented in these statistics. Finally, UNM faculty and staff on other visa types are also not represented due to lack of accurate data on these individuals.

Some scholars continued to be unable to begin programs at the University of New Mexico during this timeframe due to issues related to the COVID19 pandemic such as unavailability of visa appointments or travel issues. While there was an increase in the number of scholars coming to UNM, the numbers have not yet returned to pre-pandemic levels.

Observations


- There was a 133.85% increase in the number of J-1 scholars over the prior year (from 65 to 152)
- Scholars came to UNM from 41 countries.
- More than 59.21% of J-1 scholars came from Spain, China, India, Brazil, and Italy.
- The top 5 disciplines (more than 88%) for this year's J-1 scholars were: Life Sciences/Biological Sciences, Visual & Performing Arts, Physical Sciences, Engineering, and Health Sciences.
- 72% of scholars were funded from US sources such as UNM, the US government and private US sponsors, while 28% of scholars were funded by their home government, a private foreign sponsor, International Organization or personal and family funds.




